Docking and undocking the dashboard in Platform Symphony

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Introduction to dashboard docking and undocking

In Platform Symphony 6.1.1, a new feature was introduced to enable dashboard docking and undocking.

To dock the dashboard

When the dashboard is docked, it is a part of the Symphony console, which is a single browser window. The docked dashboard is displayed as a tab in the header navigation, in line with Workload, Resources, etc.

To undock the dashboard

When the dashboard is undocked, it is displayed in a separate browser window, apart from the rest of the console.

Tips

1. When logging into the Platform Management Console, the dashboard is docked by default, with a single browser window. The docked dashboard displays as a tab in the header navigation, in line with Workload, Resources, etc.
2. Click the "Undock" link on the docked dashboard page to switch the console to the Workload tab. (By default, the Symphony application list page is shown). At the same time, the dashboard opens in a new browser window (on top).
3. After the dashboard is undocked, it displays in a separate browser window, apart from the rest of the console. You can monitor the dashboard separately.
4. Click the "Dock" link on the undocked dashboard page; the dashboard will become docked again.

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
