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Deploying Your Service Package

Service packages can be deployed to a central repository using the soamdeploy and rsdeploy commands.

Tips for Quick Setup

Soamdeploy

Use this command to add and remove service packages, and view information about service packages, for consumers in a central repository.

The package is stored in `$EGO_ESRVDIR/rs/.cache/`.

When you want to deploy a service package, you can use one of the following two methods:

1. Register the application profile using the soamreg command, then run the application client.
When the client runs, the service package will be downloaded to `$SOAM_HOME/deploy`.
2. Push the service package.[Refer to RFC3051 Readme]
During the push process, the service package will be downloaded to `$SOAM_HOME/deploy`.

Rsdeploy

Use this command to add, remove, install, and uninstall service packages, and view information about service packages in the repository server.

The package is stored in `$EGO_ESRVDIR/rs/.cache/.global`.

When you want to deploy a service package, you can use the following command:

`Rsdeploy install ...`

During the installation process, the package will be downloaded to `$EGO_ESRVDIR/rs/deploy`.

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
